What is a Community Intranet?

A Community Intranet for Aged Care communities is a bit like having your own customised website, where you can control and manage the information it contains.

The Community Intranet is a community management tool that will save you time and money. It's a tool by which you can easily and efficiently communicate with your residents, providing them with a fun way to access information and services.
